Residents visit to Sadlers Wells

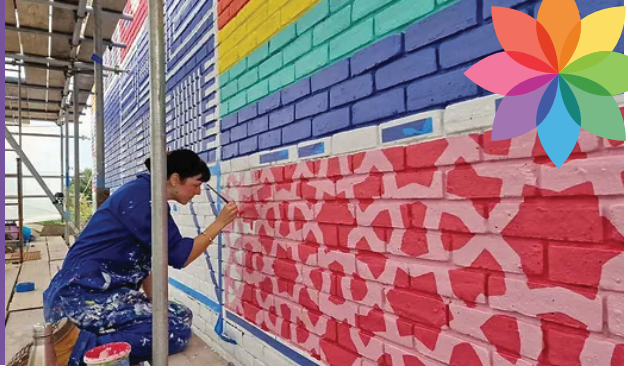

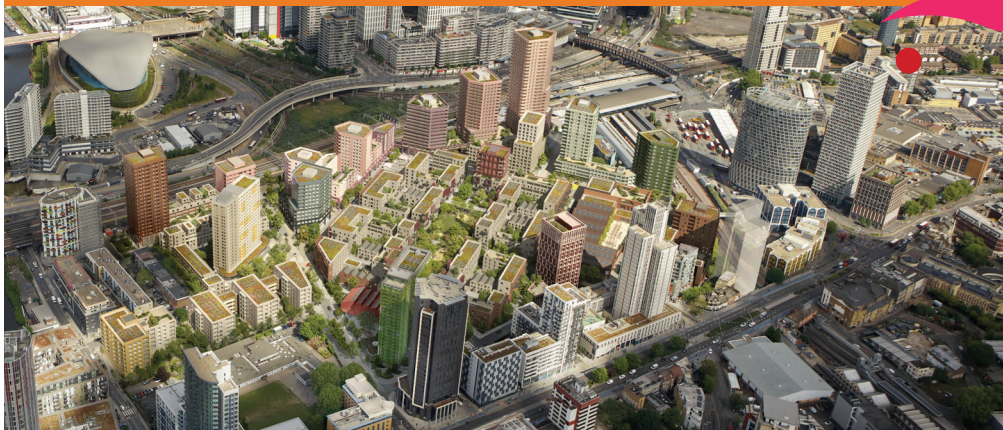
Design in the film industry with Julien

We've been working hard on the Meanwhile Use proposals for the Tenant Management Office building. This will provide a provide affordable, flexible workspaces to support entrepreneurs and artists from Newham, a courtyard for events, flexible community spaces, foodbank/community grocery run by the Carpenters Café, food and drink traders and Populo's new office.
